ABOUT

The Peer2Peer Mentor Collective at San Francisco State University is designed to enhance the student experience by pairing new students, both freshmen and transfers, with peer mentors already familiar with the campus. These one-on-one mentorship supports student mentees by connecting them to campus life, resources, and professional development opportunities during their first year so that all new students can navigate their academic and personal needs. In addition to the meaningful connections that ease new students' transitions, the program facilitates the development of valuable career skills for mentors, who also expand their social and professional networks by guiding new students.

HOW IT WORKS

- 1** REGISTER: Start by completing a short online survey about yourself, including your interests, background and goals.
- 2** MATCH: You'll be paired with a mentor or mentee(s) based on your survey results. Mentees are matched with one person, while mentors typically guide 3-4 mentees.
- 3** CONNECT: Communication can occur via email, text, phone, video chat, or in person. Three meetings per month is recommended. Get in touch and decide what works best for you and your match.
- 4** COMMIT: This program requires a one-year commitment. Matching can occur quickly, sometimes before the semester starts.
